

Residential Facility

Residential Facility is also available for boy students from outside Pune at a distance of 1minute walk from the BT Aundh Center and is owned and managed by BT completely.

Few Key Points about this facility:-

- This facility consists of 4 flats on the second floor
- Each flat consists of 4 rooms with a capacity of 9 students
- Rent per month is Rs. 4500/- only.
- Location is at a walking distance of 1min from the Aundh center
- Cot, chairs plus almirah would be provided to every student.
- No separate charges for electricity, water or daily house cleaning
- Suitable Mess Options available in the vicinity.
- Admission would be on first come first serve basis due to limited availability
- College Tie Up Option available in Aundh

Fee Details:-

Security Deposit: - Rs.10, 000/- on admission

Annual Fees: - Rs. 30,000/- on admission

- Rs. 30, 000/- paid by 30th September 2016

- Rs. 25, 000/- paid by 28th February 2017

- Rs. 23,000/- paid by 30th June 2017

* This fees may be revised for subsequent years.

Rules & Regulations for Hostel Accommodation: -

Hostel accommodation is provided with the understanding that the resident student will strictly abide by the Hostel Rules currently in force or as may be enforced from time to time. Accommodation in the Hostel cannot be claimed as a matter of right. The Institute Administration may refuse accommodation to any student who is known to have grossly violated the Hostel Rules or whose presence is likely to disturb the peace and tranquility of hostel. Violation of hostel rules will make the student liable to disciplinary action including permanent expulsion from the hostels. Students must remember that hostel is the home of the student on the campus and therefore, he/she should behave on the campus as well as outside in such a manner as to bring credit to him and to the Institution. A student once admitted in the hostel, will continue to be a hostel inmate throughout the two years unless otherwise debarred from the hostel on disciplinary grounds and he will have to pay the room rent for both the years. Every student must be acquainted with all the rules and regulations of the Hostel. He must observe them strictly. Ignorance of rules will not be considered as an excuse.

1. Every student should stay in the room allotted to him. Mutual exchange of rooms after final allotment is not allowed. Violation of this rule will be considered an act of gross misconduct and entail appropriate disciplinary action including expulsion from Hostel and imposition of heavy fine.
2. No student should keep any fire-arms, lethal weapons, poisonous things or intoxicants of any kind in the Hostel. Students must not take law into their own hands, but must report all disputes to the hostel care taker. All kinds of shouting, fighting, gambling, stealing, violet knocking, maltreating or abusing are strictly prohibited. In such cases offender will be handed over to Police immediately.
3. Students shall not remain absent from their hostels during night without the prior permission of the care taker.
4. Fees payment of every installment will be made on or before due date. Failing to make payment of installment will charge late fine of Rs 200 per day.
5. Hostel deposit will be refunded on full payment of course fees & hostel fees only for the 2 years.
