About NSE: The Science and Astronomy Olympiad Programme in India has five stages. It starts with the **NSE**, a national-level exam held in November. Top scorers qualify for the **INO** in January, followed by selection for the **OCSC** at HBCSE (Mumbai), where students receive advanced training. Final team members attend a **Pre-Departure Camp** before competing in the **International Olympiads**, where Indian students often win medals.

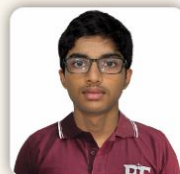

The Indian Mathematical Olympiad Programme, conducted by HBCSE on behalf of NBHM (DAE, Government of India), aims to identify mathematical talent among pre-university students. It has five stages: IOQM, a 3-hour objective exam; RMO, a 3-hour descriptive test; INMO, held nationwide for top RMO qualifiers; IMOTC, a training and selection camp at HBCSE for 65 students; and finally a Pre-Departure Camp, after which six students are selected to represent India at the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

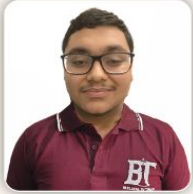

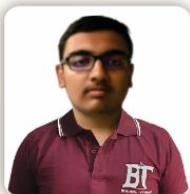

Course details

To succeed in prominent engineering entrance exams, one requires a thorough understanding of subjects: **Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics**, and the ability to solve unseen and new questions with accuracy and speed. Comprehensive course is designed in such a way that a sincere student is bound to cultivate self-confidence and acquire a grip and easy feel for all engineering entrance exams. At BT, we have mastered a 4-week format. In each 4 week cycle, we conduct (at least):

- **22 lectures**, each of 3.5 hours duration (including time for break & doubt discussion) which shall cover the entire 2 years syllabus in depth.
- **Daily tutorial sessions** [optional] of 1 hour duration (Monday to Saturday) in which conceptual problems of varied difficulty levels will be discussed. Few batches have already started with the above structure from 20th April (Monday) in which lectures are conducted 3 hours 30 minutes per day for 6 days in a week (averagely). The new batch starting from 18th May (Monday) shall have lectures for 6 days a week for 4 hours 15 minutes per day. The duration of the lecture in this new batch has been increased to get this batch in sync with the earlier batches. This batch shall get in sync with the earlier batches in around 3 months, post which it shall merge with the earlier batches.

Till the mid of October 2027, the students will be thoroughly taught all the topics from JEE syllabus. From mid October 2027, we will revise and re-revise the syllabus through lectures, systematically designed sheets and tests till the JEE Advanced exam (conducted in the 3rd or 4th week of May 2028). Also, special batches for MHT-CET/BITSAT/Boards will be floated after October 2027.

Course formats

The 2 years Comprehensive course is offered in 2 formats:

Course material & Online testing platform

BT provides all students with its detailed course material in booklet form & an online testing platform. The course material comprises **18 booklets** with detailed theory & practice questions. Solutions to all questions are provided separately. Through regular online and offline JEE-like tests, we provide a detailed & personalized analysis of the student's performance like time spent to solve each question, subject-wise comparison with toppers, topic-wise strengths & weaknesses, etc., giving vital inputs for improvement in the examination technique. Students opting for completely offline format will be requested to collect the study material from their nearest BT center in Pune. Students opting for a completely online format will get the study material via courier & will be expected to bear the courier charges.

Doubt clearing platforms

Apart from doubts discussed during the lecture, there will be various ways through which students can get their doubts cleared. Following are the platforms which students can use for the same:

1. Doubts during breaks or after each lecture:

Students can utilize break time (15 mins) or the period after lecture (15 mins) to engage with teachers individually and clarify their doubts.

2. Availability of teachers for doubts at centers for entire day:

At all centers, teachers dedicated for doubts are available throughout the day where students can discuss their doubts personally with them on a one-to-one basis.

3. Online doubt sessions:

In addition to the regular weekly lectures, we shall also conduct online doubt sessions daily (in multiple time slots) where students can interact with the teacher and get his/her doubts cleared.

Types of Batches (After Three Months)

Getting the best students together is one of the attributes that is common across all the top rank producing institutes in the country. The concept of '**merit wise batches**' allows students to study with their peers of relatively similar preparedness. This maximizes the personal growth of students. Even the teachers are able to plan their lectures well. This also creates a spirit of positive & healthy competition among the students.

With this philosophy, we have 4 types of merit-wise batches at the start of comprehensive course.

While we value every applicant's effort, meeting the minimum performance level is necessary to be considered for admission. Batch Reallocation

Based on the results of the Mid-Orientation Test and BTest 1 conducted during the online orientation, students will be reassigned batches according to their performance. Both merit and the order of preferences submitted at that time will be taken into account during the reassignment process.

1. The classes in the above batches shall be conducted for 4 hours 15 minutes per day for 6 days in a week (averagely). The duration of the lecture in this new batch has been increased to get this batch in sync with the earlier batches.
2. The syllabus of these batches shall come in sync with previously started batches in around 3 months.
3. After 3 months, students of these batches shall be merged with previously started batches (20th April), on the basis of their merit and preference.
4. Details of those previously started batches are mentioned ahead in this leaflet.
5. Few batches have already started from 20th April (Monday) in which batches are conducted 3 hours 30 minutes per day for 6 days in a week (averagely) .
6. Batch categories for new students will be assigned based on their performance in the BTests conducted over these 3 months.

9. Till the end of October 2027, the students will be thoroughly taught all the topics from the JEE syllabus (for details, see the table on the next page). From November 2027, exhaustive revision rounds will be conducted. We will revise and re-revise the syllabus through lectures, systematically designed sheets and tests till the JEE Advanced exam (conducted in the 3rd or 4th week of May 2028).
10. Special batches for MHT-CET, BITSAT and Boards will also be floated after October 2027. Students who wish to attend these batches are allowed to attend these batches along with their regular batch.

1. The On-Spot Entrance Exam will be conducted in either Offline (at selected centres) or AI-Proctored Online mode. If the student registers for the On-Spot Entrance Exam before 1.00 pm then he/she can appear on same day else have to appear for the On-Spot Entrance Exam the next day at 4.00 pm.

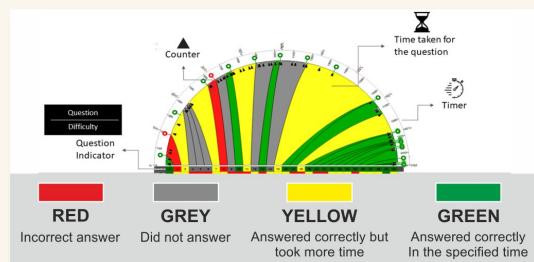

1. Unparalleled Genuine Results: Power of BT!

Unlike most institutes which do not even publish their result on their websites and thrive on fake results, we believe in absolute transparency. All the ranks mentioned by us belong to the general category unless otherwise specified clearly. All the results correspond to our classroom students. 2. Offline & Online tests with detailed analysis

5. Well Equipped Classrooms, Study Room & Library Facility

BT offers state of the art infrastructure at each of their centre with spacious, AC ventilated classrooms having Digital Boards. 6. Counseling Session after JEE Advanced Result

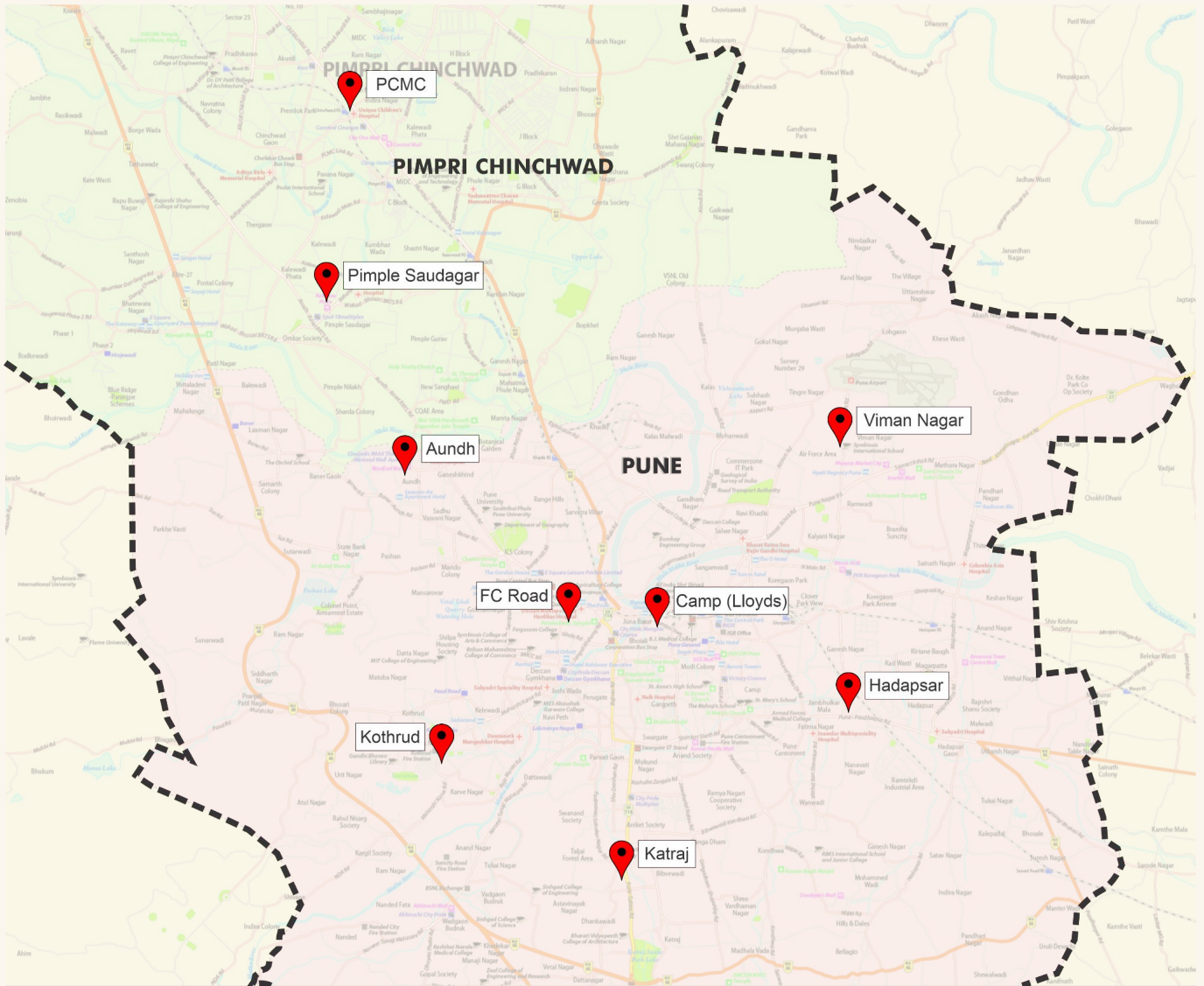
