About NSE: The Science and Astronomy Olympiad Programme in India has five stages. It starts with the **NSE**, a national-level exam held in November. Top scorers qualify for the **INO** in January, followed by selection for the **OCSC** at HBCSE (Mumbai), where students receive advanced training. Final team members attend a **Pre-Departure Camp** before competing in the **International Olympiads**, where Indian students often win medals.

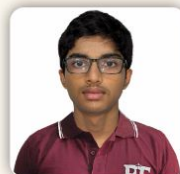

The Indian Mathematical Olympiad Programme, conducted by HBCSE on behalf of NBHM (DAE, Government of India), aims to identify mathematical talent among pre-university students. It has five stages: IOQM, a 3-hour objective exam; RMO, a 3-hour descriptive test; INMO, held nationwide for top RMO qualifiers; IMOTC, a training and selection camp at HBCSE for 65 students; and finally a Pre-Departure Camp, after which six students are selected to represent India at the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

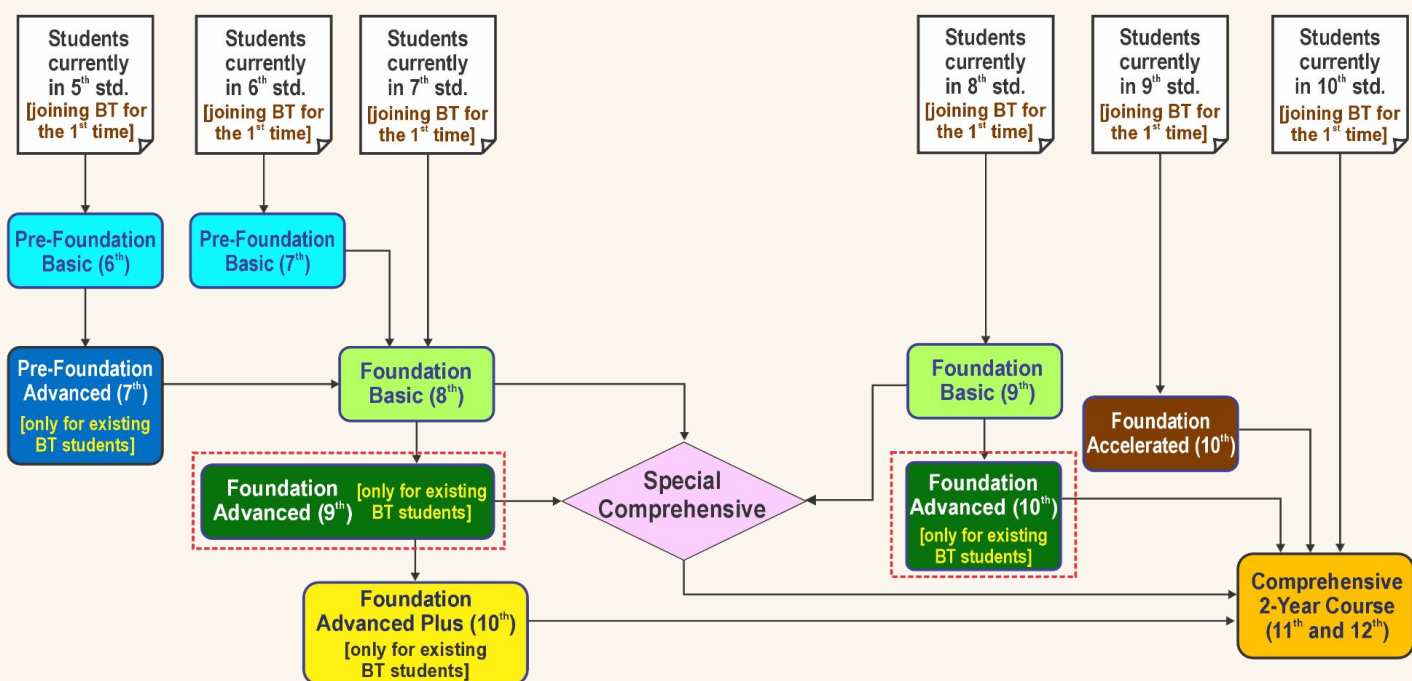

About Foundation Advanced Course

Course details

Foundation Advanced course is offered to students who successfully complete the Foundation Basic course at BT. Foundation Advanced course helps students build on the concepts of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Logic, Coding which they have learned during the Basic course.

Like Foundation Basic, we shall teach **Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Logic & Coding** in Foundation Advanced course too. **Biology** is offered as an additional optional subject in this course as well just like it was offered in the Foundation Basic course.

2 lectures per week shall be offered in the Foundation Advanced course. Each lecture shall be of 3 hours & 30 mins duration, with a 15 mins break in between. In addition to these 2 lectures per week, a few special lectures will also be conducted for **preparation of important exams like Dr. Homi Bhabha, NSEJS, SEHSS and IOQM** etc.

The following tests are also conducted during the Foundation Advanced course:

- **Lecture-Wise Practice Tests:** After every lecture, students attempt a 30-minute online test to assess their understanding of the concepts taught.
- **Pre-BTest Practice Exam:** A full 3-hour practice test is held a few days before each BTest to strengthen exam readiness.
- **BTest Every 8 Weeks:** A comprehensive 3-hour BTest is conducted every 8 weeks; performance in this test determines batch shuffling and progression to the next course.

Overall, this course is perfectly designed to carry on the momentum which students have developed during their Foundation Basic course.

Course formats

Foundation Advanced course formats:

The Foundation Advanced course is offered in 3 formats:

1. Foundation Advanced Offline (Completely offline)
2. Foundation Advanced Synergy (Offline + Online)
3. Foundation Advanced Online (Completely online)

1. Foundation Advanced Offline:

In this format, both the lectures of the week will be conducted in classroom coaching mode (offline mode). The student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his/her merit-wise category).

2. Foundation Advanced Synergy:

In this format, every week, 1 lecture shall be conducted in classroom coaching mode at our various centers and 1 lecture shall be conducted in online mode. Online lectures are live lectures as per the batch timing, which the students can attend from the comfort of their homes. For classroom lectures, student can choose a center of his/her choice (out of the options available in this format in his merit-wise category).

3. Foundation Advanced online:

In this format, students shall attend both lectures of the week online. At BT, the online lectures are live and also lively where students participate via chat and by un-muting themselves responsibly.

Course material & online testing platform

BT provides its own course material and recommends a few books for additional study which the student needs to arrange. It also provides an online testing platform which is used to conduct various practice tests and online BTests. This Online platform provides a detailed & personalised analysis of the student's performance like time spent to solve each question, subject wise comparison with toppers, topic wise strength & weaknesses etc. giving vital inputs for improvement in the examination technique.

Students opting for Completely offline or synergy format will be requested to collect the study material from their nearest BT center in Pune. Students opting for a completely online format will get the study material via courier free of cost (within India). Overseas students will be expected to bear the courier charges.

Doubt clearing platforms

Apart from doubts discussed during the lecture, there will be various ways through which students can get their doubts cleared. Following are the platforms which students can use for the same:

1. **Doubts during breaks or after each lecture:**

Students can utilize break time (15 mins) or the period after lecture (15 mins) to engage with teachers individually and clarify their doubts.

2. **Availability of teachers for doubts at centers for entire day:**

At all centers, teachers dedicated for doubts are available throughout the day where students can discuss their doubts personally with them on a one-to-one basis.

3. **Online doubt sessions:**

In addition to the regular weekly lectures, we shall also conduct online doubt sessions daily. These doubt sessions are optional and students can join them from their home for a one to one interaction with the teacher for doubts.

4. **Doubt Forum:**

Bakliwal Tutorials has an interactive doubt forum with exciting features where students can post their doubts and also solve the doubts of other students. Teachers also provide detailed video solutions of the doubts in the forum. The questions are easily searchable and are systematically available for reference and learning. Admission Process

Admission to the Foundation Advanced course will be based on the student's performance in the 4 BTests conducted during the Foundation Basic course till date. The following weights will be assigned to each BTest performance:

- BTest 1** - 25% weightage
- BTest 2** - 25% weightage
- BTest 3** - 25% weightage
- BTest 4** - 25% weightage

In case you were absent for any of these tests, the score for the absent test will be assumed to be the minimum score amongst all the tests for which you were present.

Note that a separate list of students who gave the BTests online and offline will be compiled and the available seats (and scholarships and batches as well) will be split amongst offline and online students in proportion to their total numbers.

For now, all the students of the Foundation Basic course will be asked to fill up a **Batch Preference Form** (for their choice of slot for the Refresher Program & offline/online batches after the Refresher Program get over). The details about the Refresher Program is mentioned ahead in the leaflet.

Based on merit, only selected Foundation Basic students will be offered this course. To start with, top students will be offered the Wizards batch and next set of students will be offered COC and Champion batches for the Refresher Program.

The students will be informed about their selection for this course, on **18th January 2026 (Sunday)** via email. These students need to complete the admission formalities for the Foundation Advanced course latest by **28th January, 2026 (Wednesday)**. FAQs For Foundation Advanced Course

Q1. What is the duration of Foundation Advanced Course? When does it begin and end?

Ans. Foundation Advanced is a 9-month course. Course will begin during the week starting from May 4, 2026 & ends in mid Feb 2027. However, there will be a 'Refresher Program' in the month of March/April 2026.

Q2. What is the deadline for confirming admission in Foundation Advanced course?

Ans. For the selected students, the last date to confirm the admission will be 28th January, 2026.

Q3. What about students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced course?

Ans. For students who do not qualify for the Foundation Advanced course, for now, we shall conduct a 3-week **Online Camp** in the month of April 2026 (6th April to 26th April 2026). In this online camp, there will be an optimised recap (free of charge) of the Foundation Basic course for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics subjects followed by a Camp BTest at the end. Students performing well in that test may then be offered the Foundation Advanced course. The online camp will have 6 lectures per week (Monday to Saturday) from 5:30 to 9:00 PM.

If student does not qualify for Foundation Advanced course even after this online camp, we strongly recommend that they repeat the Foundation Basic course and strengthen their fundamentals. **The fee for such students who repeat the Foundation Basic course is Rs. 31,000/-.**

Q4. What after Foundation Advanced course?

Ans. The students going to 11th standard then should join our 2-year comprehensive course. For the students going to 10th standard then, they are advised to join our 7-month course Foundation Advanced plus. This course will not only keep them in sync with JEE preparation and make them ready for the 2-year Comprehensive course from next year but also shall help them in their 10th boards' preparation.

Q5. We have heard that BT encourages a few outstanding students from 9th/10th std to attend 1 subject out of P/C/M with 11th standard students. Is that true?

Ans. Yes, this course is called the 'Special Comprehensive course'. Many top rankers from BT have benefitted from this concept. For example, Vedang Asgaonkar (JEE Adv. 2020, AIR 7), Omkar Thakoor (IIT JEE 2010, AIR 11), Soham Joshi (JEE Adv. 2021, AIR 46), Vedant Talegaonkar (JEE Adv. 2022, AIR 89), Kalpesh Krishna (JEE Adv. 2014, AIR 93), Shlok Pande (JEE Adv. 2021, AIR 94), Shubhranil Chattarjee (JEE Adv. 2021, AIR 157), Sahil Agrawal (IIT JEE 2010, AIR 176), T. Akshay (JEE Adv. 2016, AIR 182) & Arnhav Datar (JEE Adv. 2018, AIR 200) are few toppers who had benefited from this concept. In fact, all of them except Vedant Talegaonkar cleared Physics Olympiad 1st round as well, with Soham, Vedang, Omkar, Sahil, Arnhav & T.Akshay cleared 2nd round also. Vedang scored a perfect 100 percentile in Physics in JEE Main 2020. Vedang Asgaonkar, Kalpesh Krishna, T. Akshay & Arnhav Datar are toppers at their respective IITs as well.

Top students of the Foundation Basic & Foundation Advanced course (based on their performance in BTests) are offered this special program next year after completing their respective courses.

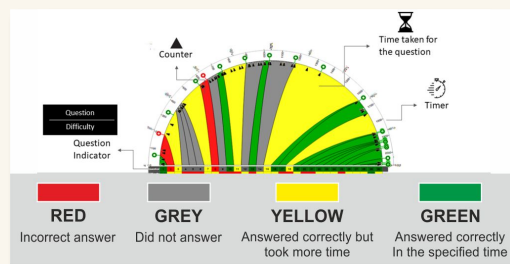
What makes BT different?

1. Unparalleled Genuine Results: Power of BT!

2. Offline & Online tests with detailed analysis

Offline and Online Tests at BT (called BTests) are thought provoking and bear close resemblance to the actual JEE paper. We analyse the tests from a student's perspective providing detailed and in-depth analytics on time management and test taking strategy. The analytics for the Online test are available immediately after test submission. The analytics of the Offline test are emailed in a couple of days.

5. Well Equipped Classrooms, Study Room & Library Facility

BT offers state of the art infrastructure at each of their centre with spacious, AC ventilated classrooms having Digital Boards. In addition to the classrooms, separate study rooms are maintained which are dedicated for students for their self study. Students can also make use of the various reference books available in the library.

6. Counseling Session after JEE Advanced Result

A detailed counseling session is conducted for all the students after their JEE and other exam results are declared. In this session, along with the teachers, senior students from BT, who have joined various IITs and other top colleges like NIT's, BITS etc. participate and guide the passing out batch on the right options to choose as per their merit and interest.

7. Student Mentorship Program

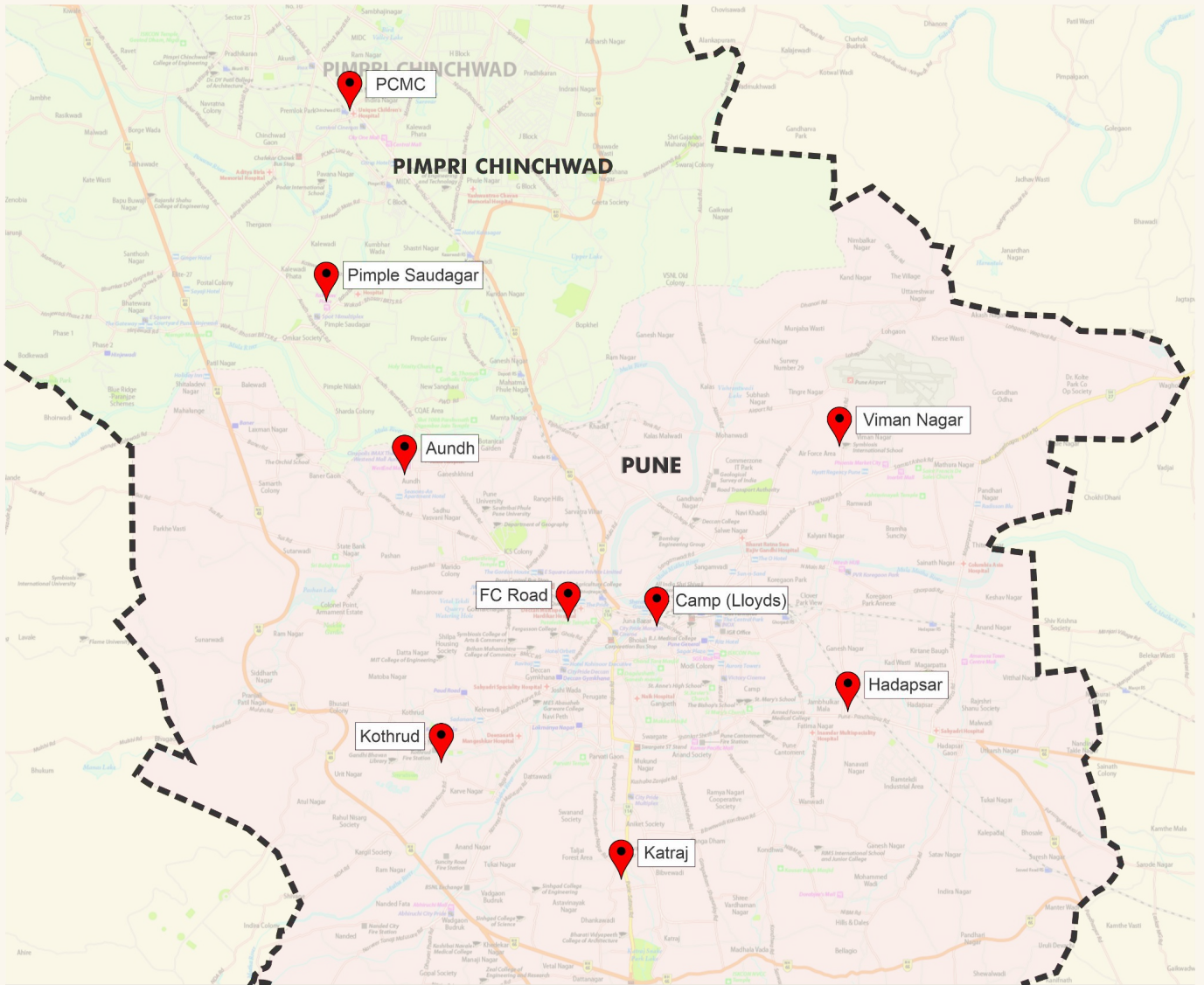
