Top scorers qualify for the **INO** in January, followed by selection for the **OCSC** at HBCSE (Mumbai), where students receive advanced training. Final team members attend a **Pre-Departure Camp** before competing in the **International Olympiads**, where Indian students often win medals.

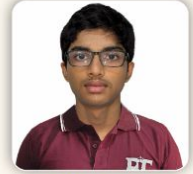

The Indian Mathematical Olympiad Programme, conducted by HBCSE on behalf of NBHM (DAE, Government of India), aims to identify mathematical talent among pre-university students. It has five stages: IOQM, a 3-hour objective exam; RMO, a 3-hour descriptive test; INMO, held nationwide for top RMO qualifiers; IMOTC, a training and selection camp at HBCSE for 65 students; and finally a Pre-Departure Camp, after which six students are selected to represent India at the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

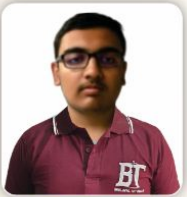

BT provides all students with its detailed course material in booklet form & an online testing platform. 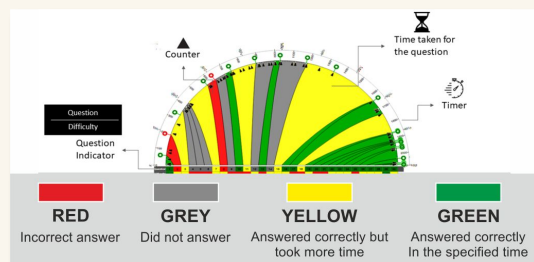

1. Unparalleled Genuine Results: Power of BT!

2. Offline & Online tests with detailed analysis

These mentors are young trainee teachers at BT, who have recently passed out from top colleges like IIT/NIT etc. Mentor keeps meeting the student at regular intervals, discusses student's academic activities in detail including the daily study routine. The mentor also keeps a check of the progress of the student and connects with the parent to discuss the same. Basically, the mentor plays the role of an elder brother/sister to the student and guides the student academically and non academically in this journey empathetically.

8. BT Culture

Out of the box events like Whizz-kid (Puzzle Competition), Felicitation Function in which meritorious students are awarded with Cash Prizes, Staff birthday celebrations, Picnic with 12th passing out students along with the faculty, Seminars, Counselling Session after JEE Advanced result etc truly make BT different.



9. Interaction with parents on child's progress

We ensure that we stay connected with parents through various ways and keep them in loop with respect to their child's progress during the preparation. Parents are also sent absenteeism SMS on daily basis and test results with detailed analysis after every test. We also conduct a seminar on effective parenting where we share our views on how parents can contribute in child's studies. PTM is occasionally conducted where one to one feedback is provided to them etc. Parents can also meet teachers occasionally after the lectures. Thus, parents are kept totally involved during the entire journey so that we work together for the intellectual growth of the child.

10. Insightful Seminars

In addition to the regular lectures, special seminars on various topics are conducted at regular intervals to guide the student on mental and other aspects which are important for JEE preparation along with the academics part. Special seminars/interaction sessions are also conducted with parents where we discuss with them as to what can be their role on their child's preparation. This ensures that students are highly motivated and aware about all the important aspects during their JEE preparation journey.

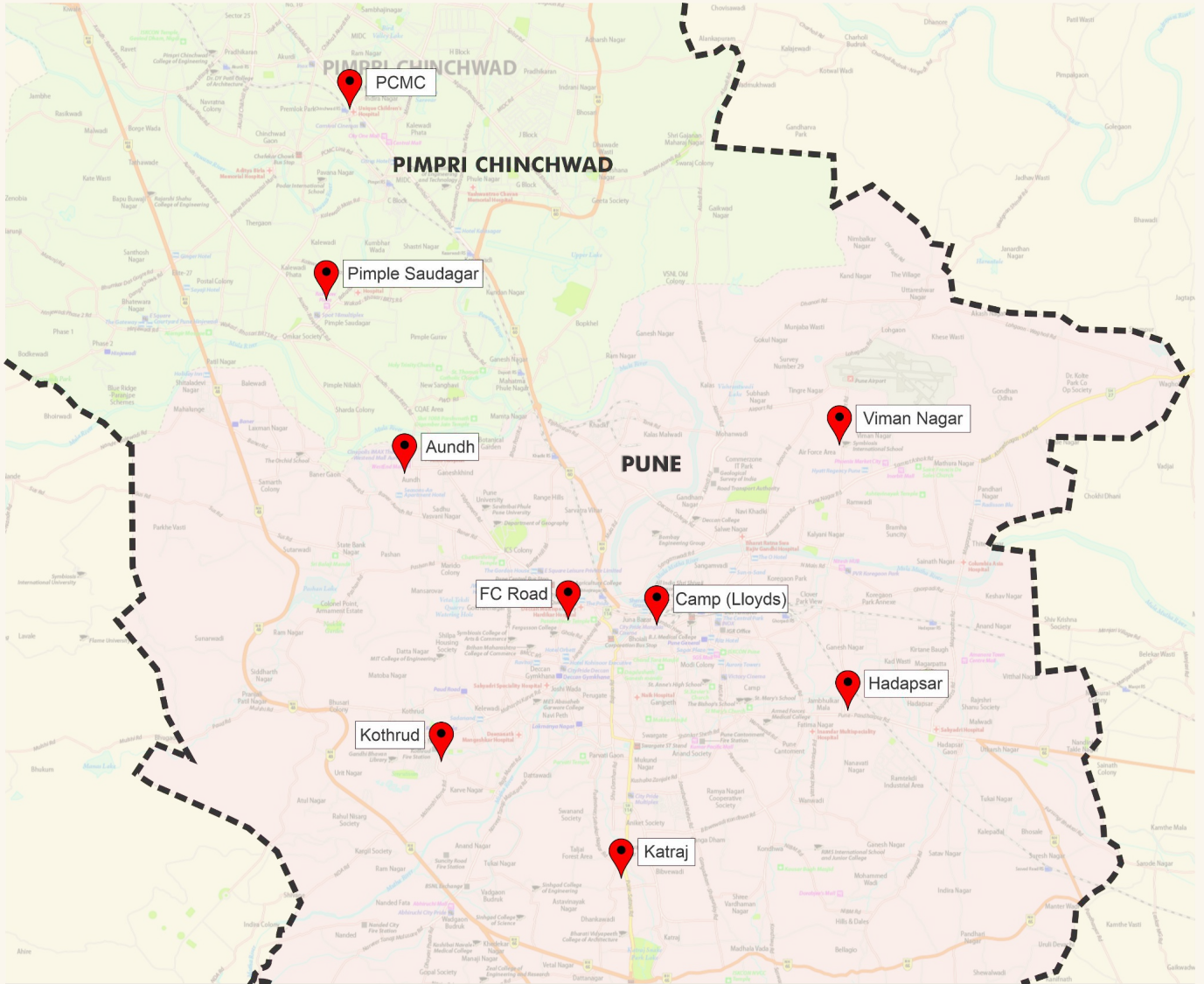
